Description of Action

Commercial Phases

Business Review and Web Needs Assessment

Action: Business review, objectives etc. → Web Site Needs assessment through stakeholder interviews and survey.

Specification Recommendations

Action: Prepare specification to meet business needs, define pages, functionalities, template or new design etc.
DEVELOP: Web Services Contract Specification

Site Specification Revisions and Approval

Action: Revise specification based on client input and gain specification approval.
REVISE: Web Services Contract Specification

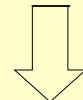
Quotation Approval

Action: Prepare and present quotation with final specification .
FINAL: Web Services Contract Specification.

Home Page Design Mock Up

Action: Complete home page mock up design
Present to client and receive revision requests

Mock Up Approval

Action: Present final home page mock up.
Receive sign off from client.

Content Development and Approval

Action: Prepare or customer provided content, graphics, etc.
Receive sign off from client.

Design and Development

Action: Complete web design and development as per specification using content provided.

Full Site Preview

Action: Present site to client and receive edits.

Complete Iterations

Action: Complete site design and content revisions.

Publish

Action: Receive client sign off and publish.

Action: Ongoing Hosting, VAS and Web Maintenance as per agreement.
